



- 1. Photo ID or driver's license
- 2. Proof of Income: Food Stamp and AFDC award letters, check stubs, Social Security, SSI award letter, pension, child support, unemployment, workman's compensation, retirement, alimony, Section 8 Public Housing letter etc.
- 3. Proof of Expenses: You need to be able to produce all <u>current</u> bills that are part of your monthly expenses.
- 4. Children 12 and under only: Birth Certificates, Court documents or school letter showing guardianship on each child. We <u>cannot</u> accept Social Security cards or health cards on children. Children MUST live with you.




