WATER AND SEWER RATE INCREASE COMING FOR CITY OF Ocala RESIDENTS



A water/sewer rate increase of 8.0% was approved at the January 19, 2021 City Council meeting in City Council Chambers.

The rate increase takes effect on October 1, 2021 and will cost the average residential user of 6,000 gallons approximately \$5.08 per month.

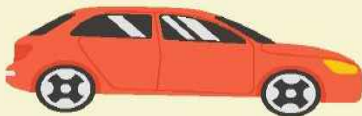

5. **Child's Wish List (3 items only) No Bicycles, iPads, Cell phones, Drones, or big-ticket items.**

The Community Council Against Substance Abuse (CCASA), in partnership with numerous community agencies, is taking a stand against drug abuse in our community and we need your help. CCASA's mission is to increase participation in the anti-drug effort and enhance coordination among all organizations that are committed to reducing youth substance use in Marion County.

CCASA is looking for sponsors to support community-wide activities planned during Marion County's Red Ribbon Week (**October 23rd – 31st**). Red Ribbon is celebrated nationally by more than 100,000 schools and organizations and is dedicated to Federal Drug Enforcement Agent Enrique Camarena, who was killed in 1985 by drug traffickers in Mexico. This week is the most successful drug prevention event organized to raise awareness about drug abuse in communities across the country.



Red Ribbon Week in our county will be launched with a Red Ribbon Kick-Off Event at The Ocala Drive-In Movie Theater on Friday, October 22, with gates opening to the public at 5 p.m.

The Kick-Off Event will feature FREE admission for 4 movies, special swag bags for youth and adult participants, and an opportunity for young people to support drug-free fun AND do so while observing social distancing recommendations.



In 2020, we had over 950 attendees at the Red Ribbon Kickoff and this year we expect to exceed those numbers at The Ocala Drive In. This is a fun filled, family event where positive drug prevention messaging is spread and free, safe alternatives for a good time are provided to the community. We will have opportunities for vendors to table below the screen prior to the movie and interact with the community, as well as free activities for families.

Following the Kick-Off Event, there will be a week of activities in our community's public and private schools where over 30,000 youth will be interacting with our Red Ribbon campaign.

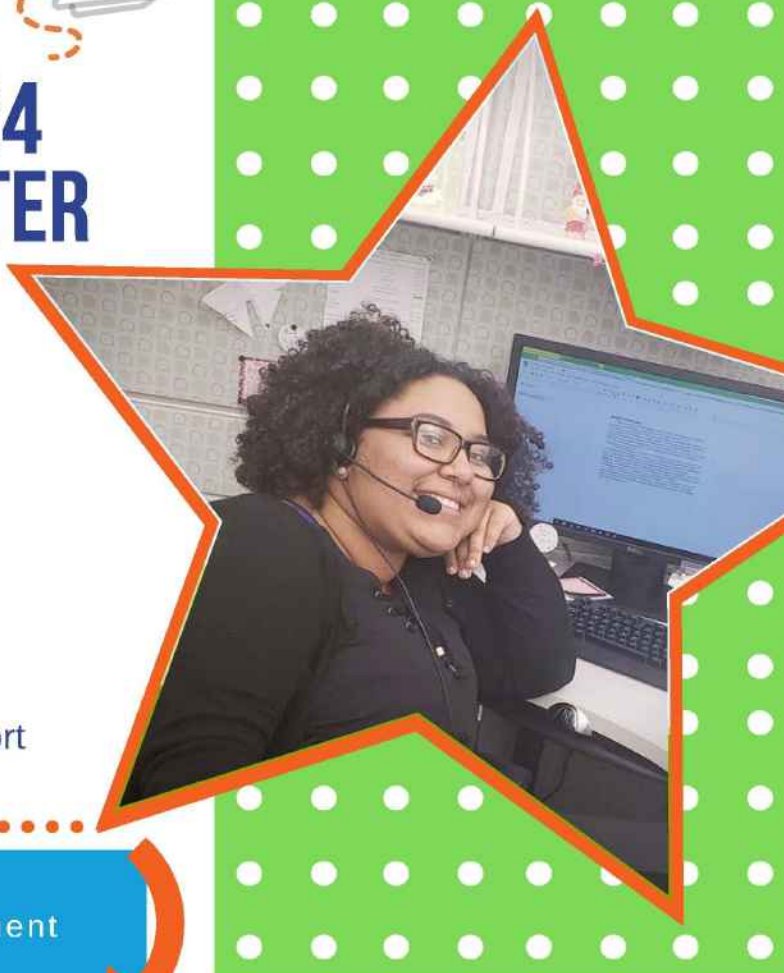
