TheFloridaScorecard.org is a dynamic online tool that identifies and tracks hundreds of state and county-specific metrics impacting the future of Florida. The Florida Scorecard allows Florida leaders and local stakeholders to measure progress within their own communities as we work towards meeting the 39 goals outlined in the *Florida 2030 Blue-print*, designed to secure Florida's future as a top 10 global economy by 2030.



DO YOU LOVE TO READ? ENJOY WORKING WITH CHILDREN?

The United Way of Marion County's ReadingPals program has served children that need additional literacy support since 2012. Some students do not know their alphabet or sounds. Help to instill that joy of reading in kindergarten students with just your investment of one hour on Tuesday & Thursday during the school day. Volunteers read a book selected by the school district that has questions in the back to guide your conversation. Fun and engaging games are vehicles to introduce new vocabulary words.

Every child with a ReadingPals receives a weekly book for their home library, thus extending the classroom into the home setting as the person who reads to the student will have the focused questions to ask. Just imagine the students' smiles when they read their first sentence! Help bring that smile to the children of Greenway or Emerald Shores Elementary.

The process of becoming a ReadingPal is easy:

- -- Attend a workshop
- -- Pass a background screening
- -- There is no cost to the volunteer for the background screening.






