The Pinwheel connotes playfulness, joy and childhood. It has come to serve as a physical reminder of the great childhoods we want for all children. The cyclical nature of the pinwheel calls to mind the positive cycles of love and support we want to help families create. The pinwheel is a symbol of hope, safety, health, and most importantly happiness.

In observance, DOH-Marion will plant a pinwheel garden:

Pinwheels will be placed in the garden to shine in the sun and will be reflective of the bright future all children deserve. It is our belief that getting it right early is less costly than trying to fix it later.

April 1st marks the beginning of
Child Abuse Awareness Month

More than 600,000 children are abused in the U.S each year.
 In 2008 we began to observe the month using Pinwheels nationally.

Did you know?
Most child victims are abused by a parent.
 In 2021, a reported 452,313 perpetrators abused or neglected a child. In substantiated child abuse cases, 77% of children were victimized by a parent.

FACTS:

- Child abuse doesn't discriminate. It spans all racial, gender and socioeconomic backgrounds.
- We **ALL** must support children who find the courage to report alleged abuse.
- We **ALL** have the responsibility to provide our children with a loving nurturing environment.
- Children are our future and communities prosper when our children thrive and succeed.
- Through education, awareness, outreach and support to children and families is how we help end abuse.

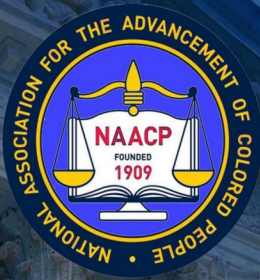

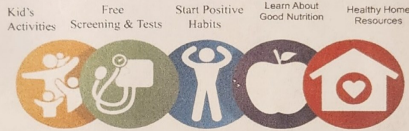
