

TRUST BASED RELATIONAL INTERVENTION (TBRI) TRAINING

Presented By:

Trust-Based Relational Intervention (TBRI), developed by Drs. Karyn Purvis and David Cross, is a trauma-informed approach designed to help children who have experienced trauma feel safe and valued. TBRI reduces negative behaviors and enhances self-worth. While originally created for vulnerable children, TBRI has applications in various settings. Community workers will find this training invaluable for effectively supporting and transforming the lives of the children and families they serve.

Joy and Stephen Zedler are the co-founders of The Pearl Project, a nonprofit dedicated to helping vulnerable children heal and recognize their value through trauma-responsive education for families and professionals. Joy, the Executive Director, holds a Masters in Human Relations, is pursuing a Masters in Marriage and Family Therapy, and is a TBRI Practitioner and Circle of Security facilitator. Stephen, the Director of Development, has over 20 years of educational experience, a Masters in Teaching Arts, and is also a TBRI Practitioner. As foster-turned-adoptive parents, they bring both professional expertise and personal experience to their work.
